

LUCKY HORSESHOES

Contest Rules

1. HOW TO ENTER

- Beginning on Monday October 31st Co-op Members may pick up a numbered “Lucky Horseshoe. Horseshoes are available at Dawson Co-op Petroleum Cardlock (Adams Rd) and Home & Agro Centre (Parkhill Dr) at the service desk. On November 8th, a representative from the Dawson Co-op will draw one number. The 4 members with that number will be declared the winners. Only 1 “Lucky Horseshoe” per member number will be allowed.
2. The contest is open only to Members of the Dawson Co-operative Union. Memberships can be purchased at anytime. Immediate family of employees, and members of the Board of the Dawson Co-operative Union are not eligible to win.
 3. Members have until closing on Monday November 7, 2011 to pick up a “Lucky Horseshoe”. A limit of 116 (4 of every number 1-29) are available on a first come first serve basis. One “Lucky Horseshoe” per member number. Chances of winning 1 in 29. A total of 4 pairs of tickets will be awarded.
 4. The number of the winning “Lucky Horseshoe” will be announced on Tuesday Nov. 8, 2011 at 8:50am on 890 CJDC and at 9am on the Dawson Co-op Community Page on Facebook
 5. Winners (4) will NOT be contacted. They must present their horseshoe with the winning number to the Dawson Co-op Administration Office prior to 5pm on Thursday November 10, 2011. Administration Office hours are from 8am to 5pm each weekday. The prize must be accepted as awarded.
 6. If the prize is not claimed no other winner will be announced.
 7. In order to be declared the winner, selected entrant will be required to correctly answer a mathematical skill testing question without assistance or mechanical or electronic aid, and sign that the official contest rules have been read and fully understood. By participating in this Contest, entrants acknowledge compliance with, and agree to be bound by, these Contest Rules and Regulations, including eligibility requirements.
